Mayor Palmer called the meeting to order at 9:00:56 PM p.m. as a special meeting, with notice of time, place, and agenda provided 24 hours in advance to the newspaper and each Councilmember.

2. Canvass and consideration of certification of the results of Syracuse City Primary Election held August 15, 2017.

A staff memo from the City Recorder explained The Syracuse City Primary Election was held August 15, 2017; the election was conducted using a vote-by-mail hybrid approach whereby all registered voters were mailed a ballot 21 days prior to the Primary Election with the option of returning that ballot via mail, via a ballot box at City Hall, or surrendering it on Election Day to vote in a traditional manner at the Syracuse Community Center.
