### ***Memorandum***

Recently the Syracuse City Fire Chief position was vacated. Administrative Staff have been working with Mayor Nagle and available council members to interview, and eventually determine the candidate to be appointed to the position. Final interviews will be completed on Friday afternoon and an offer will be extended to the successful candidates by Monday, January 30, 2012. As soon as an offer is accepted, the name and information about the successful candidate will be forwarded to the City Council for review prior to the convening of the January 31 meeting.

Update- During the January 31, 2012 Special Business Meeting the City Council voted to table this agenda item until the February 14 meeting. After much discussion, it was decided that it is necessary to address this item as soon as legally possible.

***Adopt Proposed Resolution R12-06 appointing a Fire Chief for Syracuse City.***

**RESOLUTION NO. R12-06**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE SYRACUSE CITY COUNCIL APPOINTING A  
FIRE CHIEF FOR SYRACUSE CITY.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 2.06.070 of the Syracuse City Municipal Code states that there shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the City Council, a City Fire Chief who shall perform the duties required of him by law, and shall perform such other duties as the City Council may require; and

**WHEREAS**, Mayor Nagle desires to employ a qualified individual to act in the position of Fire Chief; and

**WHEREAS**, Eric Froerer desires to work as the Syracuse City Fire Chief and the Administration, Mayor, and Council have found that he possesses the necessary skills, abilities and qualifications to do so; and

**WHEREAS**, Mayor Nagle has determined that it will be in the best interest of the City and will promote public welfare to employ Eric Froerer as the Fire Chief.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SYRACUSE CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Appointment:**

- The Syracuse City Mayor, with advice and consent of the Council, hereby appoints Eric Froerer to serve as the Fire Chief, pursuant to the City's Ordinances, Rules and Regulations.

**Section 2. Severability.** If any section, part or provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution, and all sections, parts and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
