





# OLD EMIGRATION TRAIL



The Old Emigrant Road started at Salt Lake City, and ended at the City of the Rocks, Idaho, where it formed a junction with the California Trail. This road was also known as Bluff Road, Old Traveled Road, and the Salt Lake Cutoff... Most of the emigrant travel was done during the summer months. It took them about eight days to go from Salt Lake City to the City of the Rocks in Idaho.

- 2 Fremont Trail = 1.29 miles
- 3 Trailside Loop = .38 miles
- 4 Trailside Trail = .76 miles
- 5 Jensen Route A = .84 miles
- 6 Jensen Route B = .97 miles
