

SECTION I: EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Syracuse Town Center Plan establishes the framework for the development of a unique area surrounding 2000 west and 1700 south. The plan is to define a vision for a Town Center to preserve and establish a sense of community by promoting Syracuse's farming heritage, focusing civic functions downtown, and develop quality mixed used (commercial and residential) activities, capture tourist related travel to Antelope Island and enhance pedestrian amenities. The Plan also provides the vision for an area that is inter-connected with other land uses via an open space/trail system, as shown on Figure 1. Additional defining features of the concept include integration of existing civic services and park area.
